

## **College of Science and Engineering Policy on Outside Employment for Assistantship Holders**

Outside employment for students holding financial aid carrying stipends is discouraged. The College assumes that the student's primary obligation is toward graduate study. Before committing to outside employment, the student must submit a written request to the Graduate Program Director describing the proposed job, the hours it will require per week, and the benefit it will bring to the student's program of study. The Graduate Program Director and the Dean may require that the student modify the commitment to the outside employment or relinquish the financial aid employment.
